



National Occupancy, Average Rate (ADR), and Revenue Per Available Room (RevPAR) Trends




Demand and ADR Decelerated through May; Supply Holds Steady





In 2018 >45% of Hotels in U.S. Reported GOP Decline




HOST Operating Stats – Labor Expenses Rise at Greater Rate than RevPAR




Supply Outpaced Demand in 2018



2018 RevPAR Performance






Portland's occupancy anticipated to recover in 2021 as new supply is absorbed
